[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

CAD INCIDENT DISPOSITION CODE: [12-0] [ U ] [ 3 ] [ ]

On 12/11/19, at 401 Limerick Lane, in Escambia County, Florida, Daniel Jeremy Hux did commit the offenses of two counts of attempted homicide on two law enforcement officers. The facts and circumstances are as follows:

On 12/11/19, deputies responded to 401 Limerick Lane in reference to a suicide threat. Dispatch advised that S/Daniel Hux had contacted the Escambia County Emergency Medical Dispatch and advised that someone was trying to steal his son from Pensacola Christian Academy. Escambia County Emergency Dispatch transferred S/Hux to the Sheriff's Office Dispatch, where he advised the dispatcher that someone was trying to kidnap his son. After speaking to the dispatcher for a few moments, S/Hux advised the dispatcher that he needed to go to the hospital and get medicated. Sheriff's Office Dispatch transferred S/Hux back to Escambia County Emergency Dispatch, where he advised he needed an ambulance because he was feeling suicidal. S/Hux advised dispatch he was not feeling violent and did not have any weapons.

Deputy Shoemaker #178, and Sgt Lee #113, arrived on scene at 401 Limerick Lane where they were advised by dispatch that S/Hux was under a pine tree at that address. V/ [REDACTED] observed no individual under any pine trees at 401 Limerick Lane. V/ [REDACTED] then attempted to make contact at the residence by knocking on the front door of 401 Limerick Lane. V/ [REDACTED] knocked repeatedly on the front door of the residence with no answer, while V/ [REDACTED] walked to the back-side of the residence. After V/ [REDACTED] receiving no answer at the front door, V/ [REDACTED] made her way to the front door area where V/ [REDACTED] walked away from the front door and began walking to the carport area (east side) of the house. While V/ [REDACTED] was walking to the carport area, V/ [REDACTED] continued to attempt to make contact at the front

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door, knocking repeatedly. After reaching the carport area, V/ [redacted] observed S/Hux in the carport area with a handgun and S/Hux immediately began firing at V/ [redacted] V/ [redacted] who was wearing his Sheriff's Office uniform with Escambia County Sheriff's Office emblems, drew his duty weapon and returned fire. V/ [redacted] was hit multiple times after retreating to the driveway area of the residence. V/ [redacted] after hearing the gunshots, immediately responded to V/ [redacted] location where she drew her duty weapon. S/Hux then retreated back into the residence where V/ [redacted] immediately began rendering aid to V/ [redacted] and attempted to move him from the driveway, out of harm's way. While V/ [redacted] was attempting to move V/ [redacted] S/Hux began firing again at V/ [redacted] and V/ [redacted]

Responding deputies responded where S/Hux was taken into custody.

V/ [redacted], who was struck multiple times, was transported by F.D.L.E. in one of their unmarked vehicles immediately to West Florida Hospital, where a short time later he was transported by EMS to Sacred Heart Hospital.

A criminal history was completed on S/Hux, which revealed no prior felony convictions.

An iPhone was seized from S/Hux' wife and transferred to Deputy Barton #238, where it will be submitted as evidence.


F.D.L.E., Investigations, and Crime Scene responded to the scene where F.D.L.E. took over the scene and the investigation.

There is no known video evidence of the incident.

Due to the above facts and circumstances, a Warrant Affidavit is being prepared for judicial review.

Time spent on investigation, six hours.



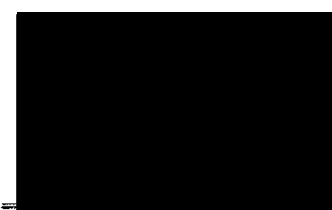
