OCSO ARRESTS MAN CAUSING DISTURBANCE ON ROOFTOP



A man who climbed onto a home's rooftop near Fort Walton Beach and began stomping around ultimately had to be pepper sprayed and tased to get him to comply with Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office deputies Tuesday afternoon.

25-year old Daniel Forgione is charged with aggravated assault, felony criminal mischief, resisting arrest, possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Deputies were called to a home on Opp Boulevard around 5:45 a.m. after the frightened homeowner said someone was stomping around on her sunroom roof causing structural damage. A neighbor saw Forgione pulling away vinyl siding and kicking the chimney repeatedly. When confronted, he says Forgione armed himself with a long pole with a three pronged garden tool and thrust it at him.

Forgione remained on the roof yelling and screaming until deputies removed him by force.

After being taken into custody they found a metal tin in his pants pocket that contained suspected fentanyl.

Damage to the victim's home was estimated at \$5000.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On March 3, 2020, at approximately 0555 hours, Daniel Michael Forgione, committed felony offenses which occurred at 207 Opp Boulevard NE, Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

Forgione climbed on top of the sun room of the above residence, owned by [REDACTED] (Victim), via a ladder. Once on top of the aluminum roofing, he began to walk and stomp on it, which caused at least 2 ceiling beams to

crack, bend, and warp thus compromising the structural integrity. Forgione was then seen by witness, Robert Worthington, tearing the vinyl siding away from the chimney. Forgione then began kicking the chimney repeatedly so hard internal pieces could be heard breaking. Worthington confronted Forgione, who then armed himself with a long pole which had a three pronged metal garden tool attached to it. Forgione thrust the approximate 10 foot pole forward from the top of the sunroom toward Worthington (Victim) in an aggressive manner coming within 2-3 feet of his person. Forgione's actions caused Worthington to back away in fear for his safety. Forgione then told Worthington he had a firearm as he prepared to throw the pole at Worthington and continued to threaten to do so. The witness backed away due to fear.

For the next three hours, Forgione refused numerous lawful orders to come down from the roof. It was obvious Forgione was under the influence of some intoxicant and continued to yell, scream, and utter gibberish. Force was eventually used to remove Forgione from the roof and take him into custody.

The victim Hough estimated the cost to repair the roof of the sunroom at approximately \$4,000.00 and the cost to repair the chimney to be approximately \$1,000.00. Total estimated value of the damaged property is \$5,000.00.

Search incident to arrest, a metal tin was located inside Forgione's pants pocket. The tin contained a plastic corner bag which had a powdery substance inside. The substance rendered presumptive positive results for fentanyl.

Based on my investigation which included interviews with the suspect, victims, and physical evidence, I have reason to believe and do believe, Daniel Michael Forgione violated F.S.S. 806.13(1)(B)(3) Criminal Mischief over \$1,000.00; F.S.S. 784.021(1)(A) Assault W/Deadly Weapon without Intent to Kill; F.S.S. 893.13(6)(A) Possession of a Controlled Substance without Prescription, F.S.S. 893.147(1) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia; and F.S.S. 843.02 Obstruct without Violence. This incident occurred in Okaloosa County where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
